Required Courses for UF Transfer

Admission to UF is not guaranteed. A 3.0 minimum GPA is required in the following courses:

- **ART1201C - 2 Dimensional Design**
- **ART1203C - 3 Dimensional Design**
- **ART1300C - Drawing 1**
- **ART1301C - Drawing 2**
- **ARH2050 - Art History 1**
- **ARH2051 - Art History 2**
- **Two additional studio courses within the chosen discipline**

Note: Applicants are strongly encouraged to complete as many studio prerequisites as possible prior to submitting application, as the work created in these courses usually contributes to a stronger portfolio. Additionally, the studio prerequisites listed above are the *minimum* requirements. It is highly recommended that students take more than the minimum required studio courses.
