The Health Services Administration (HSA) Bachelor of Applied Science degree is an online program that prepares students to be Medical/Health Services managers who are responsible for planning, directing, coordinating, and supervising the delivery of health care. Managers deal with an array of factors impacting today's health care environment: technology, regulations, accreditation, innovation in treatment and delivery, system finance, and insurance reimbursement.

Admission to the HSA program requires:

Admission to Santa Fe College, completion of an AA, AS, or AAS degree, a 2.5 or higher GPA, and a "C" or better in the following Pre-requisite courses:

- ACG2021 Financial Accounting, Or both ACG2001 & ACG2011
- ACG2071 Managerial Accounting
- ECO2023 Microeconomics
- CGS1101 Microsoft Applications
- STA2023 Statistics

Capstone: Students will complete a capstone course as part of the exit requirements for the program. The capstone experience comprises of two courses: HSA4853 (1 credit) and HSA4854 (2 credits) that are taken over two consecutive semesters. Students are required to complete a Level II background check and a Forensic 11 Panel #4211 drug test prior to enrolling in HSA4854.
