The Bachelor of Applied Science in Organizational Management (OM) is designed to prepare individuals for management and supervisory positions in a variety of professions. **The Public Safety track requires an AS degree or Certificate in Law Enforcement, EMS, or another Public Safety program.** The program provides a career and educational pathway for students who have earned an Associate of Science degree in a professional or technical discipline. This degree also provides an excellent opportunity for individuals who have already entered the workforce and are interested in acquiring business management, leadership, and supervisory skills. Students will be exposed to the theory and practice of business management including finance, economics, law, human resource management, and organizational behavior.
