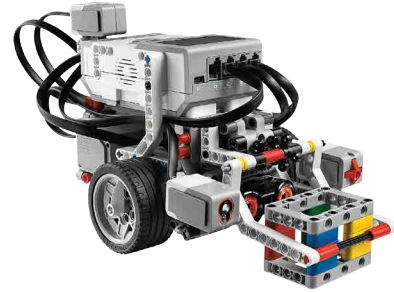

Requirements:

- Submit a completed application packet to Cheryl Canova and two personal recommendations by May 22
- Attend an office interview (will be conducted at the time application is submitted)

A limited number of CIT's are selected. Fee is \$25 and will include a t-shirt and leadership training. Verification of volunteer hours is provided after successful completion of the program. 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General Information

Registration Information

Registration begins April 12, 2017. Pay with Visa, MasterCard, Discover, or American Express either online or by phone. Pay with credit card, money order or check if you register in the office. Students will register for each class and t-shirt using course numbers. Here's how to register:

- Drop by SF Andrews Center in Starke, 209 W Call St. Hours are Mon. thru Thu., 8 a.m. — 8 p.m., and Fri., 8 a.m. — 4 p.m. when classes are in session.

Student Handbook

Students will receive information packets when their parents register at the Andrews Center, or at orientation on Tuesday, May 30 or Thursday, June 1 at 6 p.m. at the Andrews Center Cultural Building Auditorium. All first time students should plan to attend orientation sessions with their parent to go over the rules. Emergency information forms will also be completed when you register or at orientation.

Tuition

AM Session = \$80, PM Session = \$80, Full day = \$160
(includes all course lab fees and materials)

Students will receive 1 T-shirt. Additional T-shirts are available for \$8/each.

A full refund may be requested until June 2. After that date, a petition for refund must be made.

Meal Plan

Bring lunch and a drink. Students attending half day sessions who stay during the lunch period pay an extra \$20 for supervision. Full day students are not charged extra.

Transportation

Parents or legal guardians are responsible for student transportation to and from the Starke campus. For students coming to CFK ONLY: Students may be dropped off at the Cultural Building between 7:45 a.m. and 7:55 a.m. and need to be picked up promptly by 12 p.m. **All students must be picked up by 12:15 p.m.** There will be a \$15 charge assessed for students picked up after 12:15 p.m. If students are attending both programs, the students eat lunch at the Cultural Building from 12 p.m. to 12:30 p.m. and walk to the Andrews Center for the Exploring Science program.

If students are only attending the Exploring Science program, drop off is at the Andrews Center at 12:30 p.m. and pick up is 4:30 p.m. Pick up is 4:30 p.m. at the Andrews Center if students are attending both programs. **All students must be picked up by 4:45 p.m.** There will be a \$15 charge assessed for students picked up by after 4:45 p.m.

Student Rules

SF will be in session during CFK and all CFK students are required to follow the rules expected of all SF students. Students will participate in class, act in a disciplined manner, and follow faculty instructions. A contract of understanding will be signed by the student and parent/guardian. One infraction will generate a warning. At the second infraction, the student will be expelled from the CFK program without a refund.
