From Spring 2016 to Spring 2017, 10 Graduate surveys were collected.

Student Satisfaction is very important to the Building Construction Management Technology program and the graduate survey results confirm that student satisfaction is at a high level. Relating to the educational experience and satisfaction with the quality of faculty and facilities, the majority of responses were at the highest levels. Results also show that 90% of students had full time employment following graduation. In addition, incumbent workers enrolled in the program received an increase in salary and higher-level positions upon graduation. Though all responses are positive, it is the aim of the program to earn the highest results from future graduates.
