General Eligibility

To submit, a student must be a Fall 2014 or Spring 2015 student *enrolled for college credit at SFC*.

Entry Requirements

Written entries must be submitted electronically by email in Word format (.doc, .docx, or .rtf) to zephyr@sfccollege.edu. Photos and other visual art should be sent in one of the following formats: .jpg, .tiff, or .pdf. You may submit multiple entries. Each entry should include its own cover page and be sent separately to zephyr@sfccollege.edu. Additionally, a printed entry form must be either signed by you and submitted to the English Department in P-146 or filled out electronically and sent by email from your Santa Fe College email account.

Document Format

A cover page for each entry must include:

- Author's name
- Author's Student ID
- Home address and phone #
- Title of entry

Include in upper right corner of each entry page:

- Title of entry
- Author's ID#
- Page number

Maximum Length Requirements

Poems must not exceed 67 lines. Essays must not exceed 2,000 words. Fiction must not exceed 3,000 words.

The following *must* be printed and completed and submitted to the English Department in P-146 OR filled out electronically and sent by email from your Santa Fe College email account.
