In accordance with Florida Statutes, you are hereby informed that failure to file a protest within the time prescribed in Section 120.57(3), Florida Statutes, shall constitute a waiver of proceedings under Chapter 120, Florida Statutes. This notice will be posted for review by interested parties for a period of 72 hours from the time indicated on this notice.

Any person who files an action protesting a decision or intended decision pertaining to contracts administered or purchases by the College pursuant to Section 120.57(3) shall post, at the time of filing the formal written protest, a bond payable to the College in an amount equal to one percent (1%) of the estimated total volume of the award. The aforementioned bond shall be conditioned upon the payment of all costs which may be adjudged against him/her in the administrative hearing in which the action is brought and in any subsequent appellate court proceeding. In lieu of a bond, the College may accept a cashier's check or money order in the amount of the bond. If, after completion of the administrative hearing process and any appellate court proceedings, the College prevails, it shall recover all costs and charges that shall be included in the final order judgment, excluding attorney's fees. Upon payment of such costs and charges by the person protesting the award, the bond, cashier's check or money order shall be returned to him/her. If the person protesting the award prevails, he or she shall recover from the College all costs and charges which shall be included in the final order of judgment, excluding attorney's fees.
