Essays: Please respond to the following essay questions. (Not required for Scholarship renewal)

- **Narrative Autobiography:** This statement should provide information not elicited elsewhere in the application, such as leadership roles, family, educational, philosophical, or other life experiences that have influenced your achievements and career decision. You may also include professional and civic activities that you consider

important. The narrative should be concise, emphasizing those areas most important to your intellectual and personal development. (Max: 500 words)

- **Honors / PTK Membership:** Why did you choose to become a member of the Honors Program at Santa Fe College and/or Phi Theta Kappa? What has been the most positive experience(s) resulting from your membership? (Max: 500 words)
- **Optional Essay:** We consider financial need as one of the factors in selecting James Gregg Honors Scholarship recipients. By submitting this application, you agree to allow us to check your financial aid history, including Pell Grant award history. You may also provide an essay explaining any special or additional financial circumstances relevant to your financial need not necessarily captured in your financial aid history (e.g., out-of-state or international tuition, job or business losses, extraordinary family medical expenses, expenses for disabled children, etc.).
