SCREENING RESULTS DUE BY Noon - August 7, 2015

EMS Programs requests that you be drug tested at First Choice Urgent Care who provides immediate results directly to EMS Programs. Drug test results will not be accepted directly from an applicant. For your convenience, First Choice Urgent Care also provides physicals and immunizations.

- (1) You must be drug tested at least one week prior to the class start date (please refer to SF semester schedule dates). This will ensure that EMS Programs will receive results before your class starts. If you choose to be tested by your healthcare provider or a hospital, please be aware that test results may take longer to process, and EMS Programs may not receive results on time. You will not be allowed to attend class until drug screen results are received.
- (2) When you arrive at First Choice Urgent Care you must tell them that you are there to be tested for SF EMS Programs and present the **“Request for Testing” form below**.
- (3) You must show a valid photo ID when you go for testing.
- (4) Testing will take approximately 15-30 minutes, depending on the number of people present for testing. Please plan accordingly.
- (5) ***The student is responsible for payment of Drug Screening Services.***
