2. Since you applied after the deadline, **your name will not appear** in the commencement program.
3. If you are not a current student, you may need to **readmit** before your graduation application can be processed. The readmit button will appear on your eSantaFe account if your records are on history.
4. Diplomas are mailed 4 to 6 weeks after graduation to the address indicated below. If your address changes, please notify the Graduation Office in R-213 or (352) 395-5456.
