Title: **Building Program - Uniform Building Code Compliance** **Rule 6.11**

General Authority: FS 553.73, 633.0215, 1001.64(34)
Law Implemented: FS 1013.37, 1013.38, 1013.371; FAC 6A-2.0010

Effective Date: February 19, 2002

Purpose: To ensure that all renovation, remodeling, and new construction at the college is in strict accordance with the most recently adopted State Uniform Building Code for Public Educational Facilities Construction, Florida Fire Prevention Code, the State Requirements for Educational Facilities (SREF), and other applicable sections of law, building codes, and life safety codes.

The Board of Trustees will ensure compliance with the above-referenced statute by requiring that the President, or his/her designee, adhere to the requirements of the referenced statutes with respect to the design, plan review, and construction inspection of all renovation, remodeling, and construction activity. Detailed procedures are contained, and updated as required due to changes in code, in the Office of Facilities Services Operational Review Manual within the Facilities Services department of the college.
