**Title: Board of Trustees Scholarships Rule: 7.14**

General Authority: FS 1001.64, 1009.23, 1009.29

**Purpose:** To authorize and approve the award of Board of Trustees Scholarships, which are intended for the primary purposes of recruitment and assisting students in need.

The award amount of each scholarship type shall be determined by the Vice President for Administrative Affairs/CFO and the Vice President for Student Affairs. Tentative award amounts for each scholarship type will be determined by December 1 for the following year, with final determination made after fees have been finalized.

Scholarship recipients in need of additional financial aid beyond their scholarship funds should apply for federal student financial aid in accordance with Rule 7.27 and for funds from other sources, including state, private, and Santa Fe College Foundation.

The College is authorized to award need-based scholarships with merit-based components utilizing such categories as "in-district, first time in college," "in-district transfer," "in-district returning," "out-of-district," and "Honors Program."

The College is further authorized to award scholarships in focused areas such as creative arts, student government, academic teams, athletics, baccalaureate, College Achievement Program, public safety, career and technical education, and student ambassadors.

The President is authorized and directed to adopt procedures governing the administration of scholarships, including details such as deadline dates, criteria, eligibility, amounts awarded, and selection of students.
