Title: Academic Objectives and Attendance Rule 7.21

General Authority: FS 1001.64
Law Implemented: FS 1001.64; 6A-14.0261, FAC

Effective Date: October 15, 1981

Purpose: To state that failure to satisfy academic objectives, including attendance, may have an adverse effect on course grade.

Students are responsible for satisfying the entire range of academic objectives as they are defined by the instructor in any course. Attendance requirements are included in the academic objectives of each course. These objectives shall be presented in writing by the instructor at the beginning of each class. Absences shall count from the first class following registration. Lateness or leaving early may be considered as absences. Failure to satisfy any of the course objectives may have an adverse effect on the grade earned in the course or may result in the student receiving no credit in the course.
