

ESCOT - Expectations for Student Conduct On Trips

As a student about to engage in a College trip sponsored by Student Life, it is important that you abide by certain guidelines that relate to safety, liability, and general conduct. While on any College activity, you are representing not only yourself and your organization, but also Santa Fe College (SF).

Students who do not complete and sign this form may not participate in this trip.

1. **Drinking:** No student (regardless of age) may consume alcoholic beverages while on a Santa Fe College trip.
 - “Santa Fe does not provide for the sale or distribution of alcoholic beverages on any its properties or facilities. The use, possession, and/or distribution of alcoholic beverages at the College or as part of any SF activity are prohibited.” (Student Handbook)

2. **Sleeping Arrangements:**
 - a. Students of the opposite sex may not share the same room/sleeping quarters
 - b. Advisors and students may not share the same room/sleeping quarters
 - c. Students will be financially liable for any room charges (phone calls, room service, pay-per-view, etc.) and any applicable damage charged to rooms to which they were assigned.

3. **Conduct:** Students representing SF may not leave the pre-approved conference/event area and/or the hotel/sleeping quarters without advisor(s) approval. Students will actively participate in all events, pre-planned tours, activities, etc. as designated by the advisor(s).

4. **Transportation:** All students will leave Santa Fe College and return to the College via College-approved vehicles and drivers.

5. **All Santa Fe policies, the Student Conduct Code, and local, state, and national laws are to be followed as a participant of this SF trip.**

6. If any of the above rules are broken while on this trip, disciplinary action may result. This includes, but is not limited to, being sent home at the student’s expense before the trip ends or being prohibited from traveling on future Student Life trips. Additional consequences of not following these rules and procedures are prescribed in the SF Student Handbook.
